Alex: Oh Jesus! I feel so blessed. Thank you O! Lord, thank you for your grace. I was shackled and thrown into a dark, lightless room, but now this brilliant, white light, this future, this open space fills my heart with joy. Is this really happening? Or is all of this a dream? Yes, this is happening. This is reality.

Thank you so much for putting this food on my table today, for bestowing me with all the goodness that life can offer. Everything starts with you and ends with you. You, my Lord, are the ultimate King, the king of kings.

Cameraman: So how was your day?

Alex gets up from his chair and walks around. He is animated, cheerful.

Alex: Oh! It was wonderful. The new CEO and shareholder who took charge of the bank today send around a memo.

Cameraman: What did the memo say?

Alex: It says, 1. From today it's not about profit.
2. Its not about shareholders and their money.
3. Its about customers.
4. Its about giving, and self-less giving, giving our heart and soul to the customer.
5. Its not about an agenda, it's about sacrifice.
6. Its giving for the greater good of people.
And...!

Cameraman: And!!

Alex: I don't know how He did it, but the new CEO and shareholder has managed to forgive everyone's debt. No one owes anything to the bank anymore. Today when I saw the customers weep with joy, with delight and thank the CEO with their hearts, I couldn't help but admire the new CEO

and shareholder and his mysterious ways.

Cameraman: But how did he do that?

Alex: I did not question his ways, just watched one customer after customer leave the bank with the broadest grin on their faces. So many debts were forgiven, it was great to see. I signed so many of those release forms on His behalf. I have never been happier. The new CEO and Shareholder is giving people a reason to live their life yet again.

Cameraman: Who is this new CEO and Shareholder?

Alex: The lord is the new CEO and Shareholder who is in-charge of The Bank.

Cameraman: What about me? Will he forgive my debts?

Alex doesn't say anything. The lights dim.

Alex: But all is not well. There is rebellion against this new CEO and Shareholder. *He crouches over his stomach and cringes in pain and lets out a light cry.*

The light falls on the speaker...

Speaker:
